Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) Tanks

- Carry breathing air
- Required in situations where the atmosphere is incompatible with human life
- Tanks are fitted to a frame making the SCBA complete
- Replacement plan was developed in FY 15
- Year four of a five year replacement plan

Four-Wheel Drive Pickup

- Will be used as an admin and response vehicle for the Deputy Fire Chief
- Replacing a 1991 4x4 standard transmission, light-duty pick-up that is nearing the end of its serviceable life
- Vehicle being replaced is a service vehicle that carries water rescue equipment and tows the rescue boat





Generators

- Station generators for Center and South Main Street stations
- Loss of power at these stations for more than a few hours will result in needing to close the stations

Ambulance Replacement

- Ambulances originally purchased were stock ambulances not intended to be dual service vehicles
- Trading now will ensure the City receives a guaranteed 40% of the original purchase cost toward trade-in
- New ambulances would have a projected life span of 10 years versus the 5-7 currently projected for existing ambulances

Ambulance Replacement

Differences

- Diesel engines in place of the current gasoline
- Allows for carrying of equipment that is necessary to meet the requirements of our dual role
- Reduced potential for cross contamination of contaminates found on fire suppression equipment
- Improved patient loading system intended to reduce the risk of employee or patient injury
