- 1. Eric Cousins provided an update on path forward for SNRB recommendation to Planning Board re: Ag Zone income standard and strip zones.
 - a. SNRB economics document to be posted for the next Planning Board meeting on 1 10.
 - b. Planning Board is charged with developing an ordinance amendment by 3 20 23.
 - c. Workshop and public hearing schedule to be discussed at Planning Board meeting on 1 10.
 - d. Current income threshold for building in the Ag Zone is \$15,000.
 - e. Alternative to income standard is difficult to develop. Staff is working to develop a scoring/mapping matrix to differentiate areas within the zone.
 - f. Building is now possible on a 10 acre lot under the income standard. In 2017 there was an exception established for a minimum of 6.1 acres.
 - g. Council draft amendment excludes areas of the zone within the Lake Auburn watershed.
 - h. City Council is not constrained by the Planning Board recommendation but could ultimately be challenged legally.
 - i. There will be four new Planning Board members in January.
- 2. Further discussion:

- a. Significant changes in tax rates within the Ag Zone have potential to change State revenue sharing. This should be explored prior to any changes.
- b. Any public meetings on this issue should be recorded to make them available to the general public unable to attend.
- c. Royal River Conservation Trust has developed a Co-occurrence conservation model covering parts of South Auburn which may be useful in classifying areas within the zone.
- 3. Minutes for 8 30 22, 9 27 22 and 11 29 22 were approved.
- 4. Kathy needs to step down as chair due to responsibilities in the Maine House, but will stay on the working group. New chair should be identified in January.
