DRUG TRAFFICKING ARRESTS

AUBURN, ME – Auburn Police have arrested David M Cochran, 29, of Brooklyn, New York on three counts of Unlawful Trafficking of Schedule Drugs Class B (Cocaine and Cocaine Base) and refusal to submit to arrest or detention Class E. Also arrested was Lloyd L. Lyttle, 30, of Sabattus, Maine on Unlawful Trafficking Schedule Drugs Class B (Cocaine), Falsifying Physical Evidence Class D, Failure to Submit to Arrest or Detention Class E and Violation of Conditions of Release Class C.

On August 24, 2020 Auburn detectives were in the Turner Street area investigating suspicious drug activity. A male, later identified as David M. Cochran, was observed fleeing the suspect apartment building. Officers were able to apprehend Cochran a short distance from the building. Upon apprehending and identifying Cochran, they located 18.3 grams of cocaine, 6.6 grams of crack cocaine.

Additional detectives and patrol officers responded to assist in securing the apartment building while a search warrant was being obtained. While officers were securing the building, a male later identified as Llyod L. Lyttle, fled the building by jumping off the roof and running away. Detectives were able to quickly apprehend Lyttle. While apprehending and identifying Lyttle, a bag containing 62.1 grams of was located.

Approximately \$7,500 in suspected drug proceeds was seized from Cochran and Lyttle.

David M. Cochran's bail has been set at \$25,000.00 cash.

Lloyd L. Lyttle's bail has been set at \$50,000.00 cash
