DAYTIME BURGLARY ARREST MADE

Today at approximately 11:00am, Auburn Police responded to a reported burglary in progress on Trapp Rd. Responding officers received eyewitness information about a male seen exiting a residence and fleeing the area in a vehicle.

Officers located the suspect vehicle traveling on Poland Rd. The suspect, 35y/o Ryan Laflamme of Auburn, failed to stop for officers and drove to his residence on Poland Rd where he was apprehended. During the course of the investigation, officers discovered evidence that connected Laflamme to a daytime burglary that occurred yesterday on Fletcher Rd in Auburn.

Laflamme was arrested and charged with two felony counts of Burglary, one felony and one misdemeanor count of Theft, Operating after Suspension and Failure to Stop. Laflamme was transported to Androscoggin County Jail where he is being held on \$1,000 cash bail.
