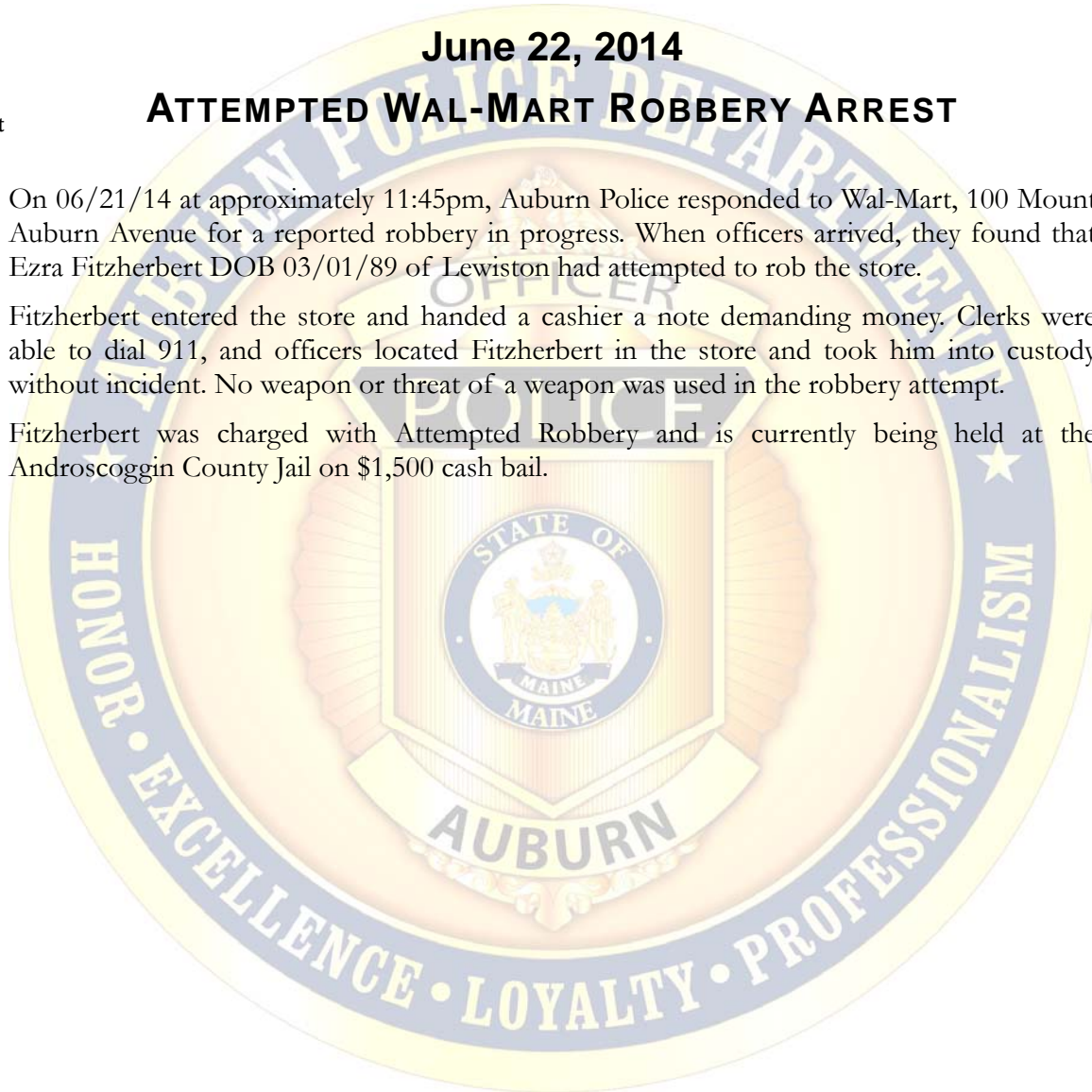

### **ATTEMPTED WAL-MART ROBBERY ARREST**

On 06/21/14 at approximately 11:45pm, Auburn Police responded to Wal-Mart, 100 Mount Auburn Avenue for a reported robbery in progress. When officers arrived, they found that Ezra Fitzherbert DOB 03/01/89 of Lewiston had attempted to rob the store.

Fitzherbert entered the store and handed a cashier a note demanding money. Clerks were able to dial 911, and officers located Fitzherbert in the store and took him into custody without incident. No weapon or threat of a weapon was used in the robbery attempt.

Fitzherbert was charged with Attempted Robbery and is currently being held at the Androscoggin County Jail on \$1,500 cash bail.
