Craig – Craig communicated with School Committee about needs for bike ped access at new elementary school

Chrissy – Universally Accessible playground meeting coming up. It was supposed to go to Marcotte park, but maybe that will change with new elementary school stuff. Her job description has shifted to assisting with complete streets work. Police are giving vouchers to kids that ride properly, such as ice cream vouchers.

Bob – been trying to promote the Dempsey Two-Mile Family Fun Ride. It's free closed course, two miles on Sunday morning. Bartlett St Mosque approached police about a bike safety rodeo. Planning to do it in May next year. May also do other bike rodeos, like in Kennedy Park. Public education work.

Nicole – More fitness instructors needed at The Gym behind Mardens.

## Minutes -

## Bartlett Street -

- Bond Money for Walnut has been moved to Bartlett Street. This makes extra money for trees if DOT won't fund that. It allows extra money for granite edging by sausage place.
- Working on survey of street. New design will be done after survey work, at least 6 weeks away. November/December will likely be new design.
- A schedule has been submitted to DOT.
- There was some discussion regarding the turning radius from Bartlett to Birch.
  Perhaps this could better be solved with someone directing traffic before and after

Colisee events.

Committee – Complete Streets is better name. We should be a committee that focuses on infrastructure for all modes of travel, and not be limited to bicycle pedestrian activities, even if those are under-represented.
