Minutes- December 10, 2018

- 1) Roll Call
 - a) Called to order at 6:03
 - b) Chair: Jordan Tate, Vice Chair: Rhyanna Larose, Commissioners: Tizz Crowley, Maurice Keene, Johnna Flood, Staff: Tony Beaulieu. Absent: Ben Low
 - c) Guests: Kathy and Joe Gray, Bill Silvester, Chris Carson
- 2) Review and Approve August and September Minutes
 - a) Correct Rhyanna's name
- 3) Public Comment/Guest Visitors
 - a) Members from the public and the MAG-ARP joined the meeting to discuss concerns over the rushed voting of their recommendation on the proposed ordinance revisions. More information on this can be found in the MAG-ARP update below.
 - b) An announcement was made by Kathy Shaw that informal weekly meetings are held behind her shop on Wednesdays at 6pm for the purpose of creating conservations of any topic brought up.
- 4) Work In Progress
 - a) Annual Report: Tizz motioned to submit the annual report as presented with necessary edits, and an LACFB recap added by Rhyanna. Jordan seconded. Unanimously voted.
- 5) Work Completed: no meetings in October or November, no work completed to address
- 6) Subcommittee Updates
 - a) Parks Subcommittee: in need of members, contact sue about posting call for members on city website.
 - b) Lewiston Auburn Community Forest Board
 - i) Dave Griswold has resigned from the LACFB
 - ii) Two vacancies for Auburn positions, along with one at large position. Ask Sue to post vacancies on city website
 - c) LA Trails: no update
 - d) Mayoral Adhoc Group (Ag Zone)
 - i) There was a recommendation to submit a letter of recommendation to the city council to postpone any vote by the MAG-ARP regarding the

ordinance changes for at least 90 days to allow for input from stakeholders. Tizz Crowley motioned, Rhyanna Larose seconded, unanimously voted.

 - a) There was a proposal to create an Auburn Forest and Agriculture Workgroup under the Conservation Commission, with Mr. Keene as the champion.
