CITY OF AUBURN ANNOUNCES NEW ASSISTANT CITY MANAGER

AUBURN, ME. – Auburn’s City Manager, Howard Kroll has announced he has hired Denis D’Auteuil to fill the role of Auburn’s Assistant City Manager.

Mr. D’Auteuil was hired in May of 2010 as Deputy Public Works Director. In July of 2012 he was promoted to Public Works Director following the retirement of long-term employee, Robert Belz. He led the reorganization of the Public Works Department, Parks Maintenance Division and Engineering Division into the Public Services Department in 2013 and oversaw a Department with an \$8 million budget and staff of 60+ employees. In January of 2015, Mr. D’Auteuil was appointed Acting City Manager by Howard Kroll.

Mr. D’Auteuil is goal-oriented, hard working and has the ability to see the “big picture.” He is a very capable administrator who has the aptitude to lead a project to the finish line. Additionally, he has a tremendous sense of humor and will be a great asset to the City Manager’s Office, to the City Council and to the community.

Mr. D’Auteuil is a long term resident of the Lewiston/Auburn area and is a graduate of St. Dominic’s High School. He is a diehard hockey player and fan so it was the logical choice for Mr. D’Auteuil to serve as the interim General Manager of the Norway Savings Bank Arena while recruiting for the current GM.
