### **PUBLIC INFORMATION SESSION TO BE HELD**

AUBURN – Upon request of the City of Auburn, the Water District recently commissioned a study to review the “swimmability” of the Outlet Beach in Auburn. Per the report, the use of this area will require additional investment by the City with “no guarantee that swimming would be available all summer long.” As a single location it is staff’s contention that the Outlet Beach area does not provide a cost effective location for swimming.

A public information session will be held at Auburn Hall, 60 Court Street, City Council Chambers on Tuesday, March 26 at 5:30 pm. Representatives from the City as well as from the consulting firm Comprehensive Environmental Inc. will be present to summarize the findings of their report and answer any questions citizens may have.
