AUBURN – The City of Auburn, in coordination with staff from the Androscoggin Transportation Resource Center (ATRC) and the Maine Department of Transportation (MaineDOT), has scheduled a follow-up public information session to discuss concerns and potential improvements for the Route 4 corridor, from Joline Drive to the Turner Town Line. The meeting will be held Tuesday, April 23, 2012, beginning at 6:00 PM at Auburn Hall, City Council Chambers.

Over the past several months following the initial public information session that occurred in October of 2012, Auburn Staff have been reviewing near miss data provided by citizens as well as information from previous studies and have been working to evaluate potential improvements to safety along the corridor.
