WHEREAS Founders Ed Stebbins and Richard Pfeffer made their investment in downtown at a critical time in the City's history, and have become an anchor institution in our revitalization; and

WHEREAS The L/A Brewpub has brewed more than 6,650 BBL's of beer, the equivalent of 1,236,900 pints served, and in the process used nearly three million pounds of barley and 5,700 pounds of hops

WHEREAS The staff of Gritty's Auburn have served up, alongside those pints, 99,800 hamburgers and over 200,000 pounds of French fries; and

WHEREAS As a Maine-based business, Gritty's is more than just a place to eat and have a pint, with more than 40 employees and contracting the services of many local vendors, Gritty's is an economic driver in our community; and

WHEREAS Through the last ten years, Gritty's has become part of the fabric of the L/A community having contributed over \$70,000 towards the Dempsey Challenge, supported Tree Street Youth, high school sports teams, the Greater L/A Triple Crown 5k Series, river paddling events, and many others too numerous to list;
