AUBURN – The City of Auburn, in coordination with staff from the Androscoggin Transportation Resource Center (ATRC) and the Maine Department of Transportation (MaineDOT), has scheduled a public meeting to discuss concerns and potential improvements for the Route 4 corridor, from Joline Drive to the Turner Town Line. The meeting will be held Wednesday, October 24, 2012, beginning at 6:00 PM at Auburn Hall, City Council Chambers.

Over the past couple of months, staff from all three organizations have been reviewing data and previous studies, and have been working to evaluate potential improvements to improve safety along the corridor. The purpose of the meeting will be two-fold: for staff of the City of Auburn, ATRC, and MaineDOT to hear the concerns and thoughts of the residents or general public who travel the corridor and for staff to outline next steps.
