Informational Meeting on Route 4 Traffic Studies

The City of Auburn is hosting an informational meeting on Thursday, June 11, 2015 to present the latest information on efforts to improve traffic safety and vehicle access on Route 4 in East Auburn and at the Lake Shore Drive intersection and to receive public input on safety and access issues at these locations. The meeting will be held in the lecture room in Kirk Hall (gym building) at Central Maine Community College and begin at 5:30 PM.

The Maine Department of Transportation (MaineDOT) is currently conducting studies to evaluate alternatives to improve safety and access at these two locations. Improvement alternatives include roundabout construction, traffic signal installation, turn-lane installation, and other potential treatments. Officials from MaineDOT and City staff from the Engineering Department will be available at the meeting to discuss the scope of the studies and listen to comments and concerns. The City of Auburn encourages people who frequently use Route 4 in the East Auburn area to attend the meeting.
