The Maine Department of Transportation is seeking public input prior to completion of the final plans for the proposed Bridge Superstructure Replacement, located on Oakdale Southbound Bridge (#5786) over Little Androscoggin River. This is located 0.09 of a mile northerly of Chasse Street. This work will include superstructure replacement, abutment reconstruction, and approach work including guardrail. A traffic detour is planned during construction.

Representatives of the Maine Department of Transportation will be present on Thursday, April 10, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. to listen to concerns, receive comments, and answer questions from anyone with an interest in the project. The Department is particularly interested in learning local views relative to project consistency with local comprehensive plans, discovering local resources, and identifying local concerns and issues. Anyone with an interest is invited to attend and participate in the meeting.

Accommodations will be made for persons with disabilities. Auxiliary aids will be provided upon advance request.
