This work will include HMA paving, restriping of a new 2-way center turn lane, drainage improvements and other incidentals.

Representatives of the City of Auburn as well as TY Lin, the engineering consultant for the project, will be present on Thursday, March 27, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. to listen to concerns, receive comments, and answer questions from anyone with an interest in the project.
