## Meet our application criteria.

- 21 years of age
- High school/GED graduate
- U.S. citizenship
- Have or able to obtain a Maine driver's license
- No criminal convictions
- Pass the ALERT test with a minimum score of 45. The ALERT test is a literacy test required for admission to the Maine Criminal Justice Academy (MCJA).
- Pass the Physical Agility Test (PAT). The PAT is also administered by the MCJA.

Please call the MCJA at 207-877-8000 for the dates/times that these tests are administered.

The selection process also includes:

- Oral board interview
- Formal background investigation (including polygraph, substance use, psychological and medical exams)



#### ALREADY A POLICE OFFICER?

Candidates currently certified as Police Officers: The city of Auburn will waive the requirements to take the ALERT and PAT for those candidates who have received certification from the Municipal/County/State Law Enforcement Program. In the case of an out-of-state candidate, the Police Chief will determine if the program is comparable to the MCJA program.

The applicant with current certifications will provide the following information:

- Completed application
- Copy of certification from MCJA or similar
- High School Diploma/GED
- College Transcript (if applicable)
- DD214 (if served in military)

Successful candidates will not be required to attend the MCJA; however, out-of-state candidates will be required to take a course on State of Maine laws.
