**Lost Valley (LV)** 

From the Auburn Mall, go through the traffic light at the intersection of Turner St. and Mount Auburn Ave. Wal-Mart and B.J.'s to the left. Continue straight for approximately 2.5 miles. The Lost Valley entrance is on the right.

From Minot Avenue, take Hotel Road and continue for approximately 3 miles to the intersection of Hotel Rd. and Young's Corner Rd. Take a left onto Young's Corner Road. The Lost Valley Access Rd. is on the right.

Follow South Main Street into New Auburn and continue up the hill. Turn left onto 7th Street, and follow to the end of the road. Walton School is on the left as you approach the end of the road.
