

The undersigned, members of the Planning Board of the City of Auburn, to which on the 18th day of July 1949 was referred by the City Council the petition of Philip R. Dasmaraiz and others, praying that a public street be laid out to be known as Dartmouth Street to be feet long and feet wide from Center Street, wasterly to Dewey Street have attended to that duty and herewith report to the City Council thereon, as follows:

Said Planning Board gave legal notice to all parties interested in the subject matter of said petition, of the time and place where it would meet to view the premises described in said petition and hear the parties, by advertising in the Lawiston Daily Sun a daily newspaper published in Androscoggin County, State of Maine, on the 21st day of July 1949 being seven days at least prior to the time appointed for said meeting, and having met pursuant to such published notice at the intersection of Center Street and the proposed Dartmouth St on the day of 19 at o'clock in the noon, and having personally examined the premises described in said petition and heard all parties interested therein and relative thereto, said Planning Board did thereupon determine and adjudge that public convenience and necessity required that a public street be laid out substantially as proposed, and accordingly we recommend that a public street be laid out to be called and described as follows:

Dartmouth Street from Center Street, westerly to Dewey Street, a distance of twelve hundred and twenty-two (1222) feet, and a width of fifty (50) feet, as laid out on the Auburndale Plan, recorded in the Androscoggin Registry of Deeds, Vol. II, B II - P. 70

Said Street is laid out over land of:

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and we have considered and estimated damages sustained in their property by the several owners aforesaid, and all other persons, by the laying out of said street, and recommend that damages be awarded as follows, to wit:

No damages claimed and none allowed

as and for the damages sustained by them respectively, as aforesaid, to be paid by the City of Auburn:

Said owners to have the right to remove and take away trees, fences, buildings and other erections from the land so taken, within sixty days from and after the acceptance of this report by the City Council.

Said Planning Board has this day filed with the City Clerk of the City of Auburn, at his office, this report, accompanied by an accurate plan and profile of said Dartmouth Street herein described and prepared by

Roscoe L. Clifford City Engineer, under it's direction, showing the length, width, lines, angles and grade of said Dartmouth Street
