## CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY APPLICATION

The Auburn Police Department is proud to offer the Citizens' Police Academy. Our next session is scheduled to begin on **January 26, 2023**. This eight-session program consists of two classes per month from 6:00pm to 8:00pm. All instructors are members of the law enforcement profession and will present material on the following topics (subject to change):

Basic patrol functions, Use of Force (lethal, less lethal), OUI detection and enforcement, domestic violence, K-9 demonstration, drug enforcement, crime scene investigations and much more.

The Citizens Police Academy is intended to be an overview of the Auburn Police Department's functions and operations. Participants will **not** be trained as police officers. Class size is limited and will be filled on a first-come basis, with preference given to Auburn residents. Applicants must be 18 years of age to participate. A background check will be performed on all applicants. Applicants with felony convictions or extensive criminal backgrounds will <u>not</u> be accepted.
