### ARMED HOME INVASION ARRESTS MADE

AUBURN, ME – On Saturday, April 7<sup>th</sup> at approximately 12:30pm, Auburn Police responded to a residence on Hampshire St for a reported home invasion. The victims reported that two masked men entered the residence armed with handguns and stole an undisclosed amount of money. No one was injured during the incident.

The subsequent investigation developed leads quickly and led investigators to Monmouth and Buckfield. A search warrant was executed at a residence in Buckfield and the following subjects were arrested:

- (1) Raiden Joyner (21) of Buckfield, ME – Charged w/ Robbery (Class A), Burglary (Class A), Theft (Class B). Held on a \$15,000.00 cash bail.
- (2) Brian Krafton (25) of Monmouth, ME – Charged w/ Robbery (Class A), Burglary (Class A), Theft (Class B). Held on a \$5,000.00 cash bail.
- (3) Ronald Hinkley (18) of Monmouth, ME – Charged w/ Robbery (Class A), Burglary (Class A), Theft (Class B), Violation of Conditions of Release (Class E). Held without bail.

All three subjects are being held at the Androscoggin County Jail. Auburn Police were assisted in this investigation by the Maine Drug Enforcement Agency, Monmouth Police Dept, Oxford County Sheriff's Office and the Maine State Police.
