


Recycling Reference Chart

 *Clear & Colored Glass	Glass bottles & jars Empty – Unbroken	Rinse clean Remove lids Place in recycling bin	No drinking glasses No Pyrex No light bulbs No ceramics No window glass No mirrors
 * #1-7 Plastic	Milk jugs Laundry detergent bottles Dishwashing liquid bottles Clorox bottles Shampoo bottles	Rinse clean Place in recycling bin	No plastic bags No motor oil containers
 * Tin Cans	Tin cans Aerosol cans Clean paint cans Empty aluminum cans	Rinse clean Aerosol & paint cans must be empty & clean	
 *Cardboard	Cardboard boxes Brown paper bags Clean pizza boxes	Corrugated cardboard must be flattened & cut into 2 ft. by 3 ft. sections <i>Do not place out when raining or snowing</i>	No Asian cardboard No paperboard boxes No cereal boxes *Recycle these materials with mixed paper
 *Newspapers & Magazines	Newspapers Advertisements Magazines Telephone books Catalogs	Place together in recycling bin <i>Do not place out when raining or snowing</i>	No plastic bags No mixed paper
 *Mixed Paper	Manila folders, Flyers, Brochures, Envelopes – manila, white, colored (windows ok), junk mail (no plastic wrappings, Cards, Post cards, Calendars, Multiple copy forms, Drink boxes (aseptic cont.), Wrapping paper including tube (no foil please), all types of paperboard boxes (shoe boxes, cereal boxes, dry food boxes, Asian corrugated (yellow or gray in color), Milk cartons, Paper towel tubes, Photocopy paper, Frozen food boxes, Egg cartons, Bound books	Place in a brown paper bag on top of your recycling bin or in clearly marked container with lid beside your recycling bin. <i>Do not place out when raining or snowing</i>	No unbagged paper No plastic bags No soiled paper towels, napkins or plates
