Additional Requirements and Information

- All on-site storage shall be within an approved exterior storage magazine.
- Maintain legible and visible warning signs, placards, and labels on site.
- The explosive permit shall be posted and presented to any representative of the fire department or the state upon request.
- Annually renew all required Auburn Fire Department explosive permits.
- Immediately notify the fire department of any fires or injuries resulting from the storage and use of explosives by calling 911.
- The 911 dispatch center must be notified at least 24 hours prior to any explosive detonation by calling their non-emergency number at: (207) 784-7331 x 1
- The Fire Code Official is authorized to inspect or observe operations at any time to ensure compliance with all safety and fire regulations.
- The Fire Code Official may revoke or suspend an explosives permit at any time.
