Olympia Operators and Ice Arena Maintenance Workers**

The City of Auburn is seeking to fill several positions for the Norway Savings Bank Arena, due to open in mid-November, 2013.

Part-time Olympia Operators -- Responsibilities include operation and maintenance of the Olympia; maintenance of records regarding repairs and maintenance of the machine, making and removing ice, maintenance of the Olympia garage; removing and replacing goal nets; maintenance of hourly and daily records on compressor unit and facility operations; performance of light construction and repairs throughout the Arena and other duties as assigned.

Part-time Ice Arena Attendants -- Duties include opening and closing doors and removing nets for Olympia operators; refill Olympia machine with flood water and wash water between ice cleaning, clean Olympia garage, clean floor from ice after each resurfacing. General maintenance of facilities include cleaning locker rooms, showers, restrooms, players benches, bleachers; keep walkways and parking lots clear of snow and litter, empty trash cans, clean and refill towel and soap dispensers, assisting the public during events; and similar duties.

Olympia Operators must have experience in the operation of ice resurfacing equipment. All positions require a great deal of interaction with the public and successful candidates must enjoy working with the public in a very busy environment. All positions require heavy physical labor for extended hours during all weather conditions and must possess valid Maine Drivers license. All positions require early mornings, nights, weekends, weekends and holiday coverage.
