History – Shoe exhibit posters are out and will be opening Friday March 29 6-8pm all are welcomed! Rachel is looking for any info on the white shoes from Auburn, if anyone has information please pass it along to her. They are looking to add a shoe fashion show soon. Auburn Historical walking tour June 8th with multiple spots. Museum LA is offering a tourism package and are looking to include the history walking tour if possible 16 spots in total. Time Capsule is looking at working with the metal school, but they need more info if possible. Middle School project is still looking for a spot to show exhibit but will end up at Museum.

It was mentioned that there needs to be a final decision on if Feb 22 202 is the close – it's a Sunday.

Keep it Local, Auburn we reached out to 150 local business to offer some type of incentive to participate. We have 10 participants so far and the list will be up on the website. We received \$800 for marketing efforts with the Sun Journal.

Art Show – all documents are done and have 15 artists submitting to the juried show and 14 vendor booths. Volunteers needs and event timeline are being worked with the parade committee. Should follow up on the food vendors as they will be the ones that need to have appropriate permitting for selling on city property.

Earth Day – will be more of a kick off effort rather just a one-day event for preparing of Memorial Day and Summer. So any event from Earth Day to Memorial Day can be listed on the website.

September Healthy Month – Chairs will be Holly Lasagna, Katie Boss, Chris Mumau (staff liaison) will meet next month to go over the outline. Original thought is to do weekly receipt with local foods, trails, geocache, and healthy tip of the day.
