ADDENDUM NO. 1

TO

CITY OF AUBURN, MAINE 2024 HOTEL ROAD PAVEMENT RESTORATION PROJECT SEPTEMBER 29, 2023

This addendum amends and /or supplements the bid documents as indicated below. Only these items alter the bid documents. Any verbal discussions or responses are hereby declared null and void. Please acknowledge this addendum on the attached Bid Form.

Clarifications to the Bid Documents:

The following changes have been made to the Bid Documents:

Question: Can the bid opening be extended?

Answer: The bid opening will be October 17, 2023, at 2:00pm at Auburn City Hall. Questions are due by 4pm October 11, 2023.

Question: Is the section of Hotel Road between Minot Avenue and Manley Road receiving 12.5mm surface or just the 4.75mm?

Answer: That section is only receiving the 4.75mm surface.

Question: Are there any gas gate valve boxes within the limits of the project that will need to be adjusted, and if so, how will this work be paid for?

Answer: The contractor will be responsible for coordinating this work with the gas company and is incidental to the project.

Question: Please supply a detail/more information about what is included/required for Item 604.164 Rebuild Catch Basin Chimney?

Answer: Contractor will need to remove material down to the top of the basin, replace with new brick & mortar, or concrete risers (anything more than 6" of required thickness) reuse existing frame and grate. Inspections of these catch basins revealed an average of 1 to 6 rows of bricks to create existing chimneys.

Question: One of the chimneys has a note that says replace frame and grate. How is this work being paid for?

Answer: Under Item 604.167 Change Catch Basin Grate to Cascade Grate. This is to include a frame and cascade grate. The chimney rebuild will be paid for under Item 604.164 Rebuild Catch Basin Chimney.

Question: Would the City accept a 3/4" non-spec gravel as an alternative if the product were made available for inspection prior to use?

Answer: Yes. The Project Manager will need to see the gravel and approve it before use.

Question: Are the slipform concrete curb tip downs required to be buried?

Answer: No, the tip downs will not be required to be buried on this project.

Question: Please provide a plan showing the locations for Item 608.26?

Answer: Each ped plate was measured out to be 2' by 6' a piece at each crosswalk.

Quantities have been adjusted on the attached bid form.

Intersections of:

Manley Road and Rodman Road Snow Avenue and Manley Road Lufkin Street and Manley Road Poliquin Avenue and Manley Road 4 corners Huard Avenue and Manley Road Maple Point and Manley Road 4 corners

Hotel Road and Manley Road

Royal Avenue and Hotel Road.

Question: Please provide a plan showing the locations for Item 609.11?

Answer: The slipform concrete curb is replacing all the existing bituminous curb. Slipform Mold 1 for curb with sidewalk, and Slipform Mold 2 for areas with no sidewalk.

Question: Please provide a plan showing the locations for Item 627.75?

Answer: Intersections of Snow Avenue, Lufkin Street, Poliquin Avenue both sides, Huard Avenue, Maple Point both sides, Hotel Road, and Royal Avenue.

Question: How is temporary striping going to be paid for?

Answer: The bid form has been adjusted with quantities and attached to this document. Temporary pavement markings will be paid for under Item 627.78 Temporary 4" Painted Pavement Marking Line, Double Yellow. Temporary pavement lines shall be painted after

milling and after the shim.

Question: How will the pavement under the curb be paid for if it comes out while removing existing curb?

Answer: This will be paid for under Item 403.209 Hot Mix Asphalt, Hand Work. This item's quantity has been adjusted in Base Bid 1 Addendum 1 and Base Bid 2 Addendum 1 and is attached to this document.

Question: Would the City consider removing Item 606.362 Guardrail, Adjust, and doing it themselves or tie it in with other work being done by the City?

Answer: No. This item will remain in the bid.

Question: Can there be any lane closures outside of 9am to 4pm?

Answer: Yes. The City will allow lane closures from 7am to 7pm. Work in the intersection of Kittyhawk Avenue and Hotel Road will be restricted to 9am to 4pm.
