Lewiston Staff Updates

- Birch, Jefferson, Caron and Walnut sidewalks have been completed. We are working to get a couple of guy wires moved out of the sidewalk.
- We plan to go to bid soon for curb and sidewalks on Howard St and Shawmut St to continue down the tree street neighborhood.
- I have not received preliminary plans yet from Gorrill Palmer on the crosswalk improvement project outlined below under design.
- Intersection Improvements Phase 1 (Main and Russell)- New ramps and ped heads have been installed. AD Electric is waiting on some equipment to make the fiber connection to the other three intersections.
- Intersection Improvements Phase 2- Preliminary plans are attached as submitted to MDOT for review for 7 intersections on East Ave plus Lisbon/Essex. We welcome the committee's comments.
- Main St- No update, waiting for survey data from MDOT to move forward with design work.
- East Ave, Homefield to Fairlawn- no update, Gorrill Palmer is working on the two way left turn traffic study
- Simard Payne/Oxford St fencing and guardrail is under construction to improve the looks of the lower canal.
- We are working with the new owners of the Continental Mill on a layout for a future riverwalk path connecting Cedar St to Simard Payne with a new pedestrian bridge over the cross canal behind Museum LA. They have already done some trimming along the river to make it more visible.
