Discussion on Council Presentation for Tot Lot and Municipal Beach - Mike said Tot lot is hard to find, GPS brought him somewhere else. Rick mentioned that he went looking for the existing trails and could not find them and trail development would make that a good park. Tim pulled up a map on his phone, we looked at the location of the Tot Lot in relation to already existing trails off Townsend Brook road. It was mentioned that connecting these trails and creating a larger trail system for this park to be the primary trail head for would open many hiking and cross-country skiing options. It was agreed that a PowerPoint presentation was the best way to go, and to have lots of pictures. We talked about meeting protocol in the COVID era.

Mt. Apatite Update - The need for more parking for the small road entrance was mentioned. He said that eventually a second entrance will be needed. Discussion around if a second entrance was necessary.

There was a discussion around the sense that Auburn is not developing greenspace.
