

Board of Assessment

The Board of Assessment Review conducts hearings in accordance with applicable state statutes for tax appeal abatements when there is disagreement with the Assessor's abatement decision. The Board may hear 1-2 appeals per year, although there have been many years without any tax appeal hearings. The Board shall act as an impartial panel, advocating for neither the assessor nor taxpayer, in rendering a decision at a hearing. Members of the Board of Assessment Review should possess the following skills.

1. Be familiar with Real Estate and Personal Property.
2. A background or knowledge in the fields of assessing, appraising, real estate or lending is helpful.
3. Willingness to attend the one night MAAO training provided for members of the Board of Assessment Review.
