Minutes from previous meetings were reviewed.

Minutes of 6/1/16: Motion by Councilor Young and Seconded by Councilor Titus to accept minutes as written. All were in favor to accept.

LIBRARY

Presentation by Director Ney. Handouts included: description, mission statement, goals and objectives and general library facts.

- Question: why don't we charge businesses for programs that they give at the Library since their presentations could potentially benefit them financially? Maime responded: We don't charge because we don't have the expertise to provide the kind of programming that they do. It's part of our mission to present programs that enrich, enlighten and engage. It's a mutual benefit to all parties.
- When authors sell their books, they will waive their fee.
- Second time within six months that Hannaford sells grocery bags for \$2.29 on our behalf and give the library \$1.00 for each one sold. In January, library received \$168.00. Library received notification that they will be beneficiary again in July 2016.
 - Councilor Walker said to be sure to give him a copy of the notification and he will distribute.
