AUBURN ANNOUNCES FIRE CHIEF APPOINTMENT

AUBURN, ME. -- Auburn's City Manager, Howard Kroll has announced the appointment of Deputy Fire Chief Geoff Low of Minot, Maine to fill the role of Fire Chief effective July 1, 2016.

Chief Low has demonstrated outstanding commitment to the Fire Service profession and to the field of emergency medicine through his educational achievements and his career experience. Chief Low has an Associate of Applied Science, a Bachelor of Science in Fire Science, and Masters of Business Administration with a minor in Public Administration from Columbia Southern University. In addition, he is currently completing the Executive Officer Program at the National Fire Academy. Chief Low began his service as a Private/Paramedic in the Auburn Fire Department in 1994 and progressed through the ranks serving as Assistant Chief of EMS Services, Acting Fire Chief and Deputy Fire Chief.

Other service includes eight years as Medical Specialist/Combat Medic with the Maine Army National Guard and Deputy Fire Chief/Paramedic in the Town of Oxford, and Med-Care Ambulance Service. Chief Low is a highly-respected instructor at the Maine Fire Sciences Institute with certifications in Incident Command, Hazardous Materials Operations, and Emergency Medical Services.

Chief Low is a native of Maine and his family has a long tradition of public service. Chief Low's training, skills, experience and leadership bring great value to the City of Auburn public safety team and will best position the Auburn Fire Department to meet the many challenges it faces.
