This free ten-session program is held each spring (April & May) and is designed for persons living or working within the City of Auburn who want to know more about the Fire Department and Emergency Medical Services. Classes are held on Wednesday nights from 6:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. and two Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Participants will have the opportunity to get "hands on" experience in a controlled environment under the supervision of trained firefighters.

Class size is limited to 15 and will be filled on a first-come basis. **A background check will be performed on ALL applicants.** Applicants with felony convictions or criminal backgrounds will not be accepted. **Applications are due no later than March 29, 2016.**
