- Employed by a Section 3 business concern or
- Currently meets or when hired met at least one of the following categories as documented within the past five years:
  - A resident of public housing; or
  - · A resident of other public housing projects or Section 8-assisted housing; or
  - A YouthBuild participant.

## Targeted Section 3 Worker Definition (for housing and community development)

- Employed by a Section 3 business concern or
- Currently meets or when hired met at least one of the following categories as documented within the past five years:
  - Living within the service area or the neighborhood of the project, as defined in 24 CFR 75.5
  - A YouthBuild participant.
