The City of Auburn is seeking to fill a full-time position of Welder. Duties include skilled welding, brazing, cutting, fabrication or heating operations using acetylene torch and electrical arc welding equipment; and operating forklift to relocate equipment for repair. Must be familiar with all types and phases of welding, including the safety procedures. Successful candidate must be extremely dependable, have mechanical aptitude and be in good physical condition and be able to pass the respiratory fitness evaluation required to wear personal protective equipment. Must be able to work in all weather conditions. This position requires operation of plow and sand trucks during winter operations. Shift work and overtime are required including nights, weekends and holidays. Must have a High School diploma or GED; a Class A or B Commercial Driver's License (CDL) issued by the State of Maine (or attained within 6 month probation period); ASE Certification in welding technology from an institute beyond the high school level; and documented history of experience and training in this field. Starting salary is \$15.96/hour with competitive fringe benefits package.
