

Housing Rehab Program Coordinator

This position is responsible to organize, coordinate and implement a variety of services and supportive activities for the Community Development Rehabilitation programs for the City of Auburn. The successful individual will facilitate the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) CDBG & HOME Rehab Program.

Additionally, this position will be responsible for daily operations including meeting with prospective clients, developing a scope of work and verifying project goals, perform inspections, drafts bids specifications, assures construction projects conform to an approved budget and monitors program outcomes. The individual will work closely with the Community Development Manager, Assistant Manager and Community Development Financial Manager.

Qualifications include bachelor's degree in public administration, public health, or business administration, 3-5 years of experience in a related field or a combination of education and work experience. A good knowledge of applicable federal and state laws and building codes is preferred. Candidates must have a Maine Drivers License and a good driving record.
