

A Note From the Rousseaus:

It is hard to believe that what started as a small power skating clinic in 1986 has grown to the states most active hockey school offering instruction in all skills including puck control, passing, game situation, checking and goaltending. Since 1986 we have taught more than 6,000 Maine hockey players to better enjoy this great game. Today, we train nearly 800 hockey players each year and employs a staff of nearly 50 instructors and counselors.

Rousseau's Hockey Clinic began with a core philosophy that players with better skills have more fun playing hockey. We believe that hockey can only truly be enjoyed through hard work and discipline. We are passionate about the game and expect all of our students to strive to be the best hockey players that they can be. We also believe that hockey can be used as a tool to develop a young person's work ethic and attention to detail that are the key attributes necessary to succeed in any endeavor. We are proud of the fact that we have not wavered from this philosophy and that we are just as passionate about helping our students improve as we were nearly 30 years ago.

Improving as a hockey player requires a long term commitment to skill development, physical conditioning and rest. We had this in mind when we designed our program. It is our belief that players gain more when practicing over a longer period of time. We are committed to offering programs that extend through a number of weeks. As a result of the constant repetition of task specific drills, while under the watchful eye of our experienced instructors, each player has ample time to absorb concepts and to attain mastery over new skills. Our practices are intense and our students and staff work very hard. Our program has been proven, not only to increase a player's skill level and speed of play, but also to improve his or her confidence, as we encourage them to carry the puck and develop on ice creativity.

Rousseau's Hockey Clinic has become the largest hockey school in the state of Maine, yet we maintain our commitment to the principles by which it was founded. We simply love the sport of hockey and the opportunity to share our passion.



The Program...

Our Summer Youth clinics offer young hockey players between the ages of 6 and 15 the opportunity to develop fundamental hockey skills and to apply those skills each week in a controlled scrimmage.

We have divided our summer youth clinic into our three core divisions. Each division will skate once a week for a total of seven weeks.

Junior Division: (ages 6 to 9) - \$285

Minor Division: (ages 9 to 13) - \$285

Major Division: (ages 12 to 15) - \$285

Each division will skate two hours per week. The first hour of ice time will consist of fundamental instruction. During the second hour of ice time, we will conduct a controlled scrimmage where we will concentrate on increasing the speed of play and offering individual instruction during playing time. Between hours, we will hold a classroom discussion where we will focus on various topics including: conditioning; mental preparation; and advanced team play.

Our youth clinics will also include instruction specific to goaltenders. We will have a goalie instructor at each session who will work with the goalies on skills specific to the position.

Each division includes 14 hours of ice time, a high quality jersey, and over 100 years combined experience in developing hockey players. A deposit of \$150.00 is due with your application, and the balance is due prior to the first session.

Applications will be accepted on a first come, first served basis and space is limited to 30 skaters and 3 goaltenders. We encourage you not to hesitate in returning your applications. Our clinics fill very quickly and we are often forced to return applications. Upon receipt of your application, we will send you a schedule and a conditioning program that we encourage you to work on in preparation for the clinic.
