Hi Eric,

Thanks for your help the other night. Below is my attempt at addressing the few comments that the planning board suggested. Let me know if these are acceptable and address all the items requested.

- LAWPCA shall make provisions in the contractual agreements to receive compost amendments to include a truck transportation routing plan that directs heavy trucks to stay on State Highway or arterial roads and away from minor roads, such as Penley Corner Road, (south of entrance to Composting Facility), Harmon's Corner Road and Old Danville Road.
- LAWPCA shall annually submit, to all property abutters via certified mail, an update of operations and plans for the future year.
- As far as the odor information, after looking through the purchase documents for Roger Gauthier there is no language which prohibits him from complaining about odor to us or the City. I did find that language existing in an old agreement he had with the Authority on the 170 Penley Corner rd parcel which we no longer have an agreement with him on. I think the comments made by Mr. Skillings are no longer valid and that Roger does indeed have the right/ability to complain about odors and any other form of non-compliance with City ordinance.

Is the next step to submit a copy of the agreement back to you with these items incorporated or do we just show up to the next meeting with the proposed language? Is October 13th @ 6 the next meeting? I assume I should attend?
