UNIVERSITY STREET SHOOTING

AUBURN, ME – This morning at 9:23 a.m., Auburn Police were called to an apartment at 46 University Street for a report of a female who had been shot in the hand. While officers were responding to the call, further information was provided that the shooter had fled the scene in his pick-up truck.

The shooter's name and vehicle description were shared with area police departments to "be on the lookout."

When Auburn officers arrived at the University Street apartment, they located a female on the back porch, suffering from gunshot wounds. The Auburn Fire Department treated the victim on-scene and transported her to Central Maine Medical Center (CMMC).

A deputy with the Androscoggin County Sheriff's Department located the suspect's vehicle in Turner near Twitchell's Airport. Auburn officers and the ASO deputy searched the area, locating the suspect in the woods suffering from a self-inflicted gunshot wound.

The suspect is identified as 40 y/o Daniel Brown of 46 University Street in Auburn. Turner Rescue responded and transported Brown to CMMC where he later died of his injuries.

The victim's name is not being released at this time.
