MAN SHOT DURING AFTER PARTY

AUBURN, ME – On June 19, 2021, around 02:00am, Auburn Police were called to the area of 409 Court St. for a report of several gun shots fired with a man down.

When officers arrived, they found Jamual Douglas, a 25y/o male of Auburn suffering from a single gun shot wound to his leg. Auburn Fire Department treated Douglas on scene and transported to Central Maine Medical Center where he remains in stable condition.

A large group had recently arrived at the Court St. apartment after leaving a club in Lewiston. According to witnesses, several shots were fired from an unknown vehicle in the direction of the group as they were standing outside the apartment building. One round hit Douglas in the upper leg, another round struck a vehicle parked in the driveway. Other shell casings were recovered by investigators.
