MALE SOUGHT IN WAL-MART SHOOTING ARRESTED

AUBURN, ME – On June 6, 2021, Sincere George 19y/o of Lewiston turned himself in to Auburn Police Detectives. Investigators were in contact with George and his family over the weekend and coordinated his surrender. George was placed under arrest at the Auburn Police Department and transported to the Androscoggin County Jail where he remains in custody.

George and a 16y/o male juvenile were wanted in connection with a shooting of a male that took place in the area of Wal-Mart Superstore on Mount Auburn Avenue on June 3, 2021. Investigators arrested the 16y/o on June 4, 2021, but George remained at large until his arrest over the weekend.

George has been charged with Elevated Aggravated Assault (class A Felony) and Reckless Conduct with a Firearm (Class C felony). His bail has been set at fifteen thousand dollars cash, with conditions that he not have contact with either the victim or the juvenile co-defendant.
