BLUE STAR FLAG FLOWN IN SUPPORT OF DEPLOYED OFFICER

Today, Auburn Police Officers raised a blue star flag at the Auburn Police Memorial located at the intersection of Court/Turner St. The flag is flying in support of Officer Scott Laliberte, who is currently deployed to Afghanistan with the 133rd Engineer Battalion.

“The blue star flag serves as a daily reminder that we have an officer in harm’s way defending our nation”, said Deputy Chief Jason Moen. A smaller flag will hang in the front lobby of the police station.

“Scott is a part of our family and we are proud of his dedicated service to our country”, said Chief Phillip Crowell. “The flag will fly until Scott returns home safely and then will be presented to him and his family at a ceremony celebrating his return.”

Police personnel will continue to show support for Laliberte while he is away, wearing red shirts on Fridays and displaying yellow ribbons with a blue line bearing Laliberte’s name.
