MARIJUANA BROWNIE ARREST MADE

Auburn Police have arrested 19y/o Isaiah Pendexter of Auburn on a felony charge of Aggravated Trafficking of Schedule Z Drugs (Marijuana)

Pendexter manufactured and subsequently sold a marijuana laced brownie to a 16y/o female juvenile. The juvenile shared the brownie with a 17y/o female at a bus stop prior to school this morning. Shortly after arriving at Edward Little High School, the 17y/o juvenile became ill and was treated by a school nurse. The juvenile was subsequently treated at a local hospital and released.

School Resource Officer Shawn Carll conducted an investigation and was able to track the sale of the brownie back to Pendexter. Carll was also able to confirm that no other marijuana laced brownies were brought onto school property.

Pendexter is currently being held at the Androscoggin County Jail on \$500 cash bail.
