NIGHT-TIME BURGLARS CAUGHT

On August 6, 2014 at 11:58pm, Auburn Police responded to Reginald Street for a reported burglary in progress. A homeowner reported to being awakened by noises coming from the basement. Officers responded and quickly set up a perimeter around the residence.

Confirming that the homeowner was safely locked in a bedroom, Corporal Bouchard deployed K9 Dutch into the basement, subsequently driving two suspects out of the residence into the arms of waiting officers.

The suspects, 34y/o Nicholas Sands and 38y/o David Giasson, both of Auburn were taken into custody and charged with Burglary (Class B felony) and Criminal Mischief (Class D Misdemeanor). Sands is facing additional charges of Unlawful Possession of Scheduled Drugs (Class E Misdemeanor) and Sale and Use of Drug Paraphernalia (Civil).

Both Sands and Giasson are currently being held at the Androscoggin County Jail on \$2,500 cash bail.

The homeowner was not injured during the incident.
