TRAFFIC STOP LEADS TO MAJOR DRUG SEIZURE AND ARREST

On Saturday, 11/08/14 at approximately 8:45pm, Officer Joseph Miville conducted a motor vehicle stop on Washington St. (South) on a vehicle with inoperative tail lights. During the motor vehicle stop, Officer Miville detected the overwhelming odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. During a search of the motor vehicle, Miville discovered 41.6lbs of marijuana in the vehicle.

The operator of the vehicle, 29y/o Oleg Spektorov of 499 Summer St. Boston, MA tried to claim that he was a marijuana medical caregiver but was unable to explain the reason why he had 41lbs of marijuana in the vehicle. Also seized was a small amount of Hashish Oil was well as items used to manufacture Hashish Oil.

Spektorov was arrested for Aggravated Trafficking in Scheduled Drugs (Class B Felony) and Unlawful Possession of a Schedule X Drug (Class D Misdemeanor) and was transported to the Androscoggin County Jail. On Sunday 11/09/14, Spektorov was released after posting \$25,000 cash bail. Spektorov is scheduled to appear in court on December 30th, 2014.
