




PROJECT OVERVIEW

- Route 4, East Auburn
 - Begins south of Oak Hill Road, extends north across causeway at Lake Auburn outlet
- Includes:
 - Oak Hill Road/Lillian Street
 - Turner Street
 - Martin Street
 - Fair Street
 - Public Boat Launch






- High traffic volumes
- Route 4 traffic speed
 - Posted at 40 mph
 - 58 mph SB, 60 mph NB measured speeds
- Side Streets
 - Difficulty accessing Route 4
 - Lack of left turn protection
 - Turner Street - LOS F (at capacity)
 - Martin Street – LOS D with slight traffic increase
 - All side streets at LOS D with projected growth




OAK HILL ROAD & LILLIAN STREET




TURNER STREET






MARTIN STREET, FAIR STREET, EAST JUG HANDLE




BOAT LAUNCH & WEST JUG HANDLE
