Public Services

- ➤ 2015 Reclamation Project- Valview Dr, Summer St. (Park Ave to Mount Auburn Ave) Touch-up work and driveways to be paved and completed by the end of next week.
- ➤ 2015 Reconstruction Project- Davis Ave, Seventh St and Tyler St. Davis Avesidewalks and driveways to be completed this week.
- > Stormwater Management- Continuing compliance on Permit Year 3.
- Crews continue to work on the Salt brine pad
- ➤ Crews continue sweeping leaves around the City, as well as Oakhill Cemetery, Raymond Park, Little Andy Park, EL Park, Drummond Park, Longely Park, Festival Plaza, Riverwalk, Bonney Park, Moulton Park and Main St.
- > Basin lines continue to be painted on East Hardscrabble, Monroe and Jefferson
- Crew member continue to assist the Electrical Department when needed
- The hot patching crew are working on the North River Rd and Falcon Dr areas
- Crews are diligently working on the playground project
- Crews are working near 2527 Turner Rd digging the banking back
