### Public Services

- 2015 Reclamation Project- Valview Dr, Summer St. (Park Ave to Mount Auburn Ave) Crews are working on loam and ditching on Valview Dr. Summer Street has been base paved and the intersection with Mount Auburn Ave has been altered. Ditching to begin next week.
- Transportation Project at Great Falls- Water main extension completed. Sewer main extension remains.
- 2015 Reconstruction Project- Davis Ave, Seventh St and Tyler St. Tyler Street and Seventh Street complete. Davis Ave has been base paved, structures are being raised to grade and curbing is being placed this week and next.
- Perkins Ridge Road Culvert Replacement- Project complete.
- Stormwater Management- Reviewing the results of the DEP audit. Continuing compliance on Permit Year 3.
- 2015 Demolition Project- 14 Newbury Street has been demolished.
- Crew attended a workplace violence training and well as winter training which included: Loader, Vehicle Inspection Reporting and Cirus controls
- Crews were busy doing maintenance sweeping around the City
- Crew continued to work on Vickery Road driveway culverts and ditching
- The welding crew have been working on the new lock mechanism of the front gate; and installing of box so they can collect leaves
- This week fleet had 18 work orders, 11 are completed for Auburn Public Services as of today. Crews had four for Police Department, with state inspections and PMs all complete.
- Fleet Vehicle info: Vehicle 86 crews are making repairs on cab floor in # 24; Vehicles currently down for maintenance and or other work including pre-winter installations, PM's # 3,24,49,50,72,212, 80,44,104; Vehicle that are going out for body work # 38,39
- Crews were busy cleaning out 60 catch basins.
- Crews continue Roadside mowing on 16s run
- Crews dug out behind central fire so staff can have trench rescue training.

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- Crews were busy working on the constructing a turnaround at the end of Allen Ave.
- Crews are busy grading Lane Road
- Sign work around the city continues; replacing and or fixing faded and damaged signs.
- Crews have begun to sweep leaves where needed
- Our facilities crew continue assist with maintenance and assisting others
- The Excavation Technician was busy marking out dig safe's, inspecting both private and street excavations, reviewing and issuing Fill, Drive Opening permits as well as billing and continues GIS work.
